

TRACY L. M. NORTON holds the Erick Vincent Anderson professorship as an Associate Professor of Professional Practice. She joined the faculty at LSU Law in 2022 after serving on the faculty at Touro University Law Center in Long Island, New York for fifteen years. Prior to the move to New York, Professor Norton taught at both South Texas College of Law and Texas Tech University School of Law. She earned her J.D. in 1994 from Baylor University School of Law with a concentration in Criminal Practice. Professor Norton's scholarship for the past twenty-five years has focused on generational competence in legal education and the practice of law, digital solutions to make legal education more widely accessible, and storytelling to advocate for those whom the law does not privilege. A long-time member of the Legal Writing Institute, she has served two four-year terms on its board.
