Deborah Pearce practices law in New Orleans, Louisiana, focusing primarily on trial development, preservation of error, and appellate practice in the federal and state courts. Her practice covers diverse subject matters, including complex commercial litigation, health care and pharmacy law, white collar crimes, contract claims, and oil and gas issues. Ms. Pearce is a Fellow of the American Academy of Appellate Lawyers and serves on the Board of Governors for the Fifth Circuit Bar Association, for which she previously served as president. For more than ten years, Ms. Pearce was the Reporter of Appellate Jurisdiction and Procedure for the Fifth Circuit Bar Association and, for almost twenty-five years, she has taught Appellate Law and Advocacy as an Adjunct Professor of Law at Tulane Law School. Ms. Pearce graduated *summa cum laude* from Tulane Law School and is admitted to practice before the Federal Fifth, Tenth, and Eleventh Circuits, all Louisiana federal district courts, the federal district court in Colorado, and all Louisiana state courts.
